The shelter program offers residents a 24 hour year round shelter providing short-term emergency protection , counseling, and numerous onsite services for women and children.

The shelter program is centered on building self-dependence and self-confidence for the residents.

Programs Offered During Shelter Stay

Next Door offers pro-active programs that are structured to enhance physical and emotional health for families.

Services offered include groups for adults and children, legal clinic for restraining orders, health education, medical check-ups, nutritional information, referrals for transitional housing, and services offered by other private and governmental agencies.

Who is Able to Live At the Shelter

The shelter is a safe place for women and children who have to leave their homes because of Domestic Violence.

Any person fitting these criteria may call our 24-hour hotline at 408-279-2962

If space is available, case managers will do a brief intake over the phone. If the shelter is full, we will refer you to other shelters.

SHELTER ENVIRONMENT

The shelter is in a residential area and does not appear different than other homes in the neighborhood. The inside is decorated like any other home and is very warm and cozy. There is 1 private room, a down-stairs room for people with physical disabilities or injuries, and a large dormitory.

The shelter is centrally located with access to public transportation, schools, and government agencies.



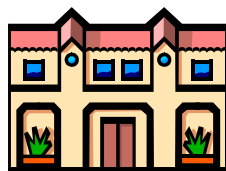
CONFIDENTIALITY, SAFETY, AND SECURITY

The shelter is equipped with an updated security system. There is staff on the premises 24-hours a day, 7 days a week. A woman's stay at the shelter is confidential during and after her stay.

KID'S CLUB & TEEN PROGRAMS

The goal is to support and educate children in ways that are age appropriate.

During their stay at the shelter, children are given assistance with their studies from their current school, or a specialized program can be arranged, such as home study.

- Police records/documentation of abuse
- Money, bank records
- Checking & savings account books

- House & car keys
- Medications, medical records, medical cards
- Children's clothing and small toys
- Pictures, address book
- Saleable objects
- Passport/immigration papers
- Insurance papers
- Rental Agreement/House Deed
- School records & immunizations
- Pictures of injuries from abuse
