- Intentionally or reckless causing or attempting to cause injury
- Placing another person in reasonable apprehension of imminent serious bodily injury to himself/herself or another.

Abusive Behavior Includes:

1. Hitting
2. Slapping
3. Kicking
4. Pushing
5. Biting
6. Pulling Hair
7. Striking with an Object
8. Sexual Assault

ARE YOU A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC

Domestic Violence is abuse committed against:

- An Adult
- A fully emancipated Minor
- A former spouse
- A cohabitant (living together)
- A person with whom the suspect has a child or is expecting a child
- A person in a dating relationship



DOMESTIC VIOLENCE INCLUDES:

1. All forms of physical violence
2. All forms of sexual violence
3. All forms of emotional violence
4. Threatening
5. Harassing
6. Stalking
7. Annoying phone calls
8. Violating a court order

COURT ORDERS

Victims of domestic violence have the right to go to Superior Court (Family Division) and file a petition requesting an order for relief:

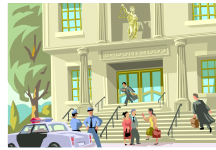
Directing the abuser to leave the household

Awarding custody of children

Awarding child support payments

Directing the defendant to make specified debit payments

Directing participation in counseling programs



EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE ORDERS

Are issued to a victim who is in immediate danger of abuse by a family member.

May be issued by a police officer when there is a history of abuse and/or threats of abuse to the family by the suspect, but probable cause for arrest does not exist.

Services Provided at the FVC by Next Door Advocate:

- Crisis counseling
- Counseling referrals
- Clothing referrals
- Referrals to 24-hr emergency shelter
- Assistance in obtaining Temporary Restraining Orders
- Educational programs for community organizations
- Process application for the AWARE alarm systems,
- Mobile Cellular Phone Programs
